My name is Alfred Gusenbauer and I am the President of the Renner-Institute in Vienna, Austria.

The Renner-Institute is a well respected political academy which developed a strong focus on Central and Eastern European affairs and has been instrumental for the democratic transition in the area. We enjoy a broad range of cooperations with academies, foundations and political institutes in Europe and the US.

As I was serving as Federal Chancellor of Austria and President of the Socialdemocrat Party ,I was able to build up a strong network with colleagues which I maintain up to now.

In this context I paid a visit to my friend Laurant Fabius this spring to discuss recent developments in Central and Eastern Europe.Our exchange of ideas and my good working relations with Gerard Sebag motivate me to propose to you a potential cooperation between the Academie Diplomatique and the Renner Institute.From all what I know,I have the impression that joining our strength would offer a very fruitful perspective .

The Eastern Partnership Summit of the EU to be held in Vilnius at the beginning of November 2013 serves as an important point of reference for the future relations between the EU and its partners in the East.One of the highlights there could be the signing of an Association agreement between the EU and the Ukraine.

Former President of Poland, Aleksander Kwasniewski on behalf of the European Parliament, is trying to resolve some of the open issues to make the AA <u>possible.By</u> the mid of September we should know where we are heading.

It is my conviction that this process merits a strong political support given the importance of the issue. Therefore I want to propose to you to co organize a conference on 'Ukraine's path to Vilnius' in Paris on September 17,2013.
