In addition, Chemezov devotes special attention to the revival of research and development work. On his initiative, the corporation recruited the legendary scientist Y. N. Koptev, who now serves as the chairman of the Scientific and Technical Council.

Additionally, Sergey Chemezov is the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Fund for the Support and Development of Physical Culture and Sports of the Russian Federation, as well as the Russian Economic University named after G. V. Plekhanov.

The Rostec CEO also heads the Department of Management for Military-Technical Cooperation and High Technologies at MGIMO University, part of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Additionally, he is a member of the Higher Attestation Commission of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation.
